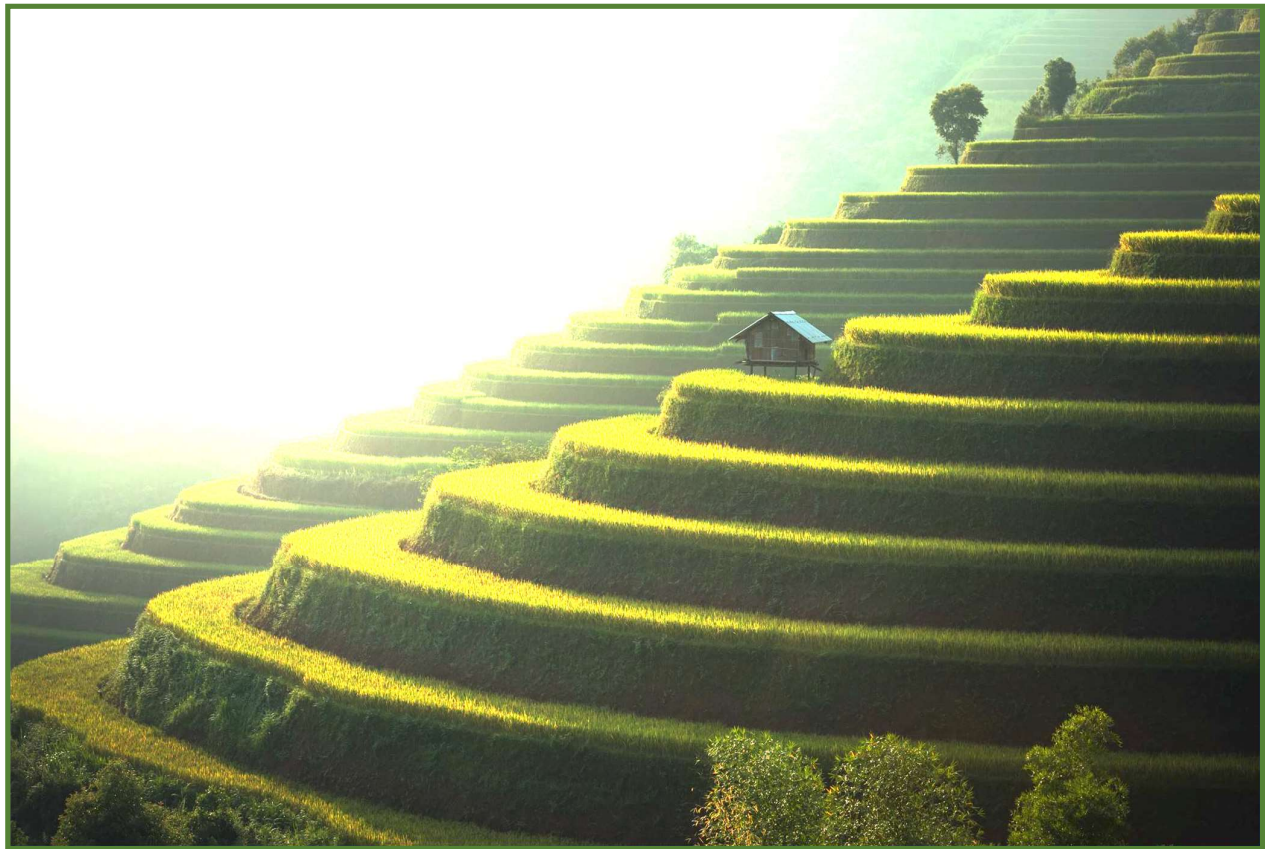

## Sustainable Rice Platform Cookie Policy

The website of the Sustainable Rice Platform (“SRP,” “us,” “our,” and “we”) uses cookies (<https://www.sustainablerice.org>). Cookies are small and commonly encrypted text files that your internet browser automatically creates and stores on your browser or device’s hard drive when you visit our site. Cookies collect information and technical details about your usage, including the date and time, pages visited, and navigation choices.

In observing this Policy, SRP is committed to complying with the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), ePrivacy Directive, and Thailand Personal Data Protection Act (PDPA).

### Why we use cookies

Cookies allow us to distinguish you from other users. We use them because they help us provide more seamless navigation of our website, customize its design and layout based on user data and preferences, and produce tailored content. In short, cookies enable us to deliver a better service and user experience.

### Types of cookies

We currently use two types of cookies: strictly necessary and performance cookies.

*Strictly necessary cookies.* These cookies are essential for you to browse our website and use its features, and they would be required for accessing secure areas of the site in the future. Although your consent is not required for the use of strictly necessary cookies, we explain their purpose, duration, and provenance.

*Performance cookies.* These cookies collect statistical information about your navigation and use of our website, including the pages you visit, links you click, and documents you download. The data collected from performance cookies are aggregated and anonymized and cannot be used to identify you. These cookies allow us to improve our website’s efficiency and design.
